



I MADE MY BASE USING ILLUSTRATION BOARD. FOAMCORE WILL WORK JUST AS WELL. TRACE YOUR FINISHED SPACE MOUNTAIN MODEL ONTO THE BOARD AND MAKE 2 CIRCLES. THE HEIGHT OF YOUR SPACERS WILL BE THE SAME AS THE HEIGHT OF THE BLUE WRAP MINUS THE THICKNESS OF THE BOARD YOU USED TO MAKE THE CIRCLES.

HOT GLUE WORKS WELL FOR JOINING EITHER ILLUSTRATION BOARD OR FOAMCORE. ONCE YOU HAVE A RIGID BASE, START WRAPPING IT WITH THE BLUE WALL PAPER. THE SKINNY SECTIONS OF BLUE MATERIAL ARE TO GIVE YOU A GLUE SURFACE AND WILL LEAVE A SMOOTH FACE AT THE SEAMS.

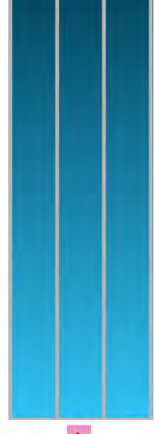
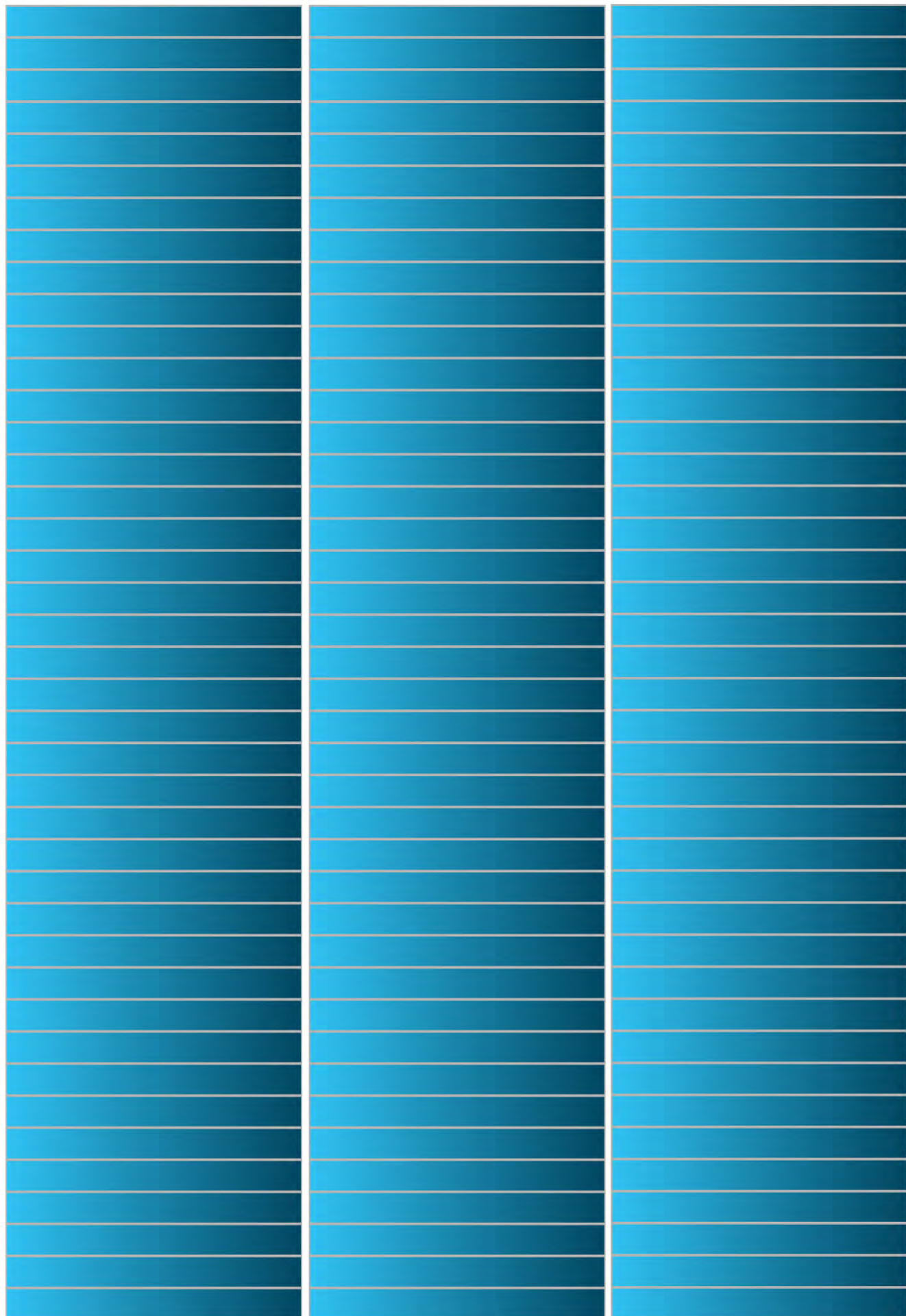


THEN GLUE YOUR FINISHED SPACE MOUNTAIN ON TOP. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO GO A STEP FURTHER, I'VE PROVIDED THE "VEINS" AS SEEN ON THE WDW VERSION OF SM. PRINT AN EXTRA COPY OF THE WHITE BASE PIECE FROM THE ORIGINAL MODEL. THEN PINCH EVERY OTHER VERTICAL VEIN ON THE MODEL AND INSTALL THE RING IN THE CENTER OF EACH VEIN.

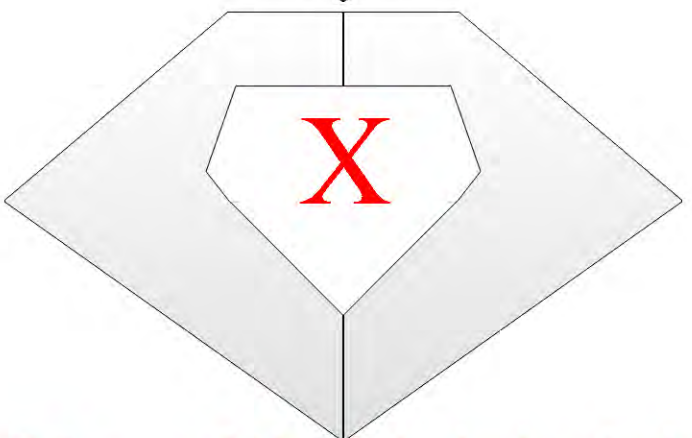
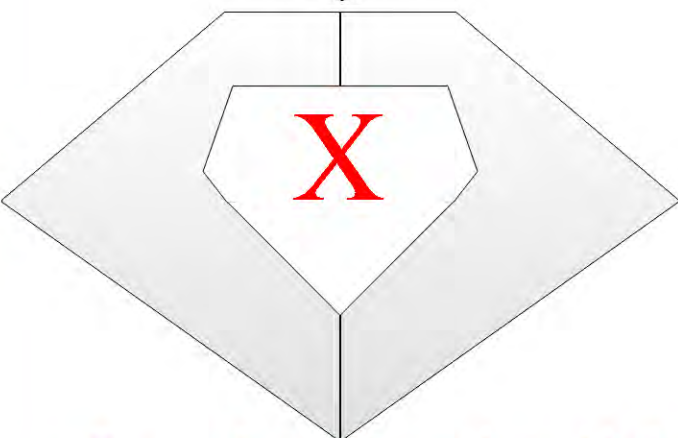
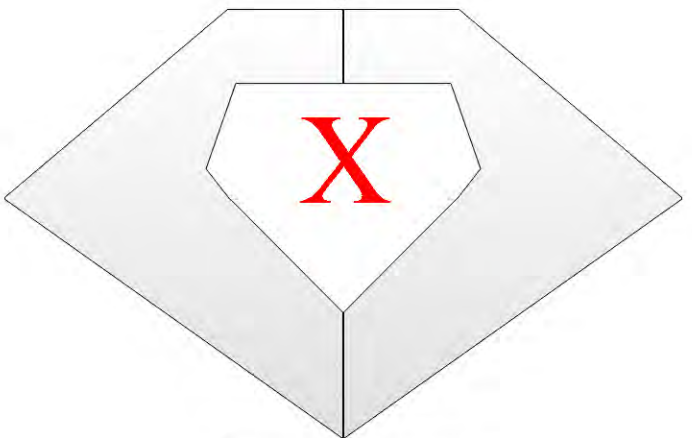
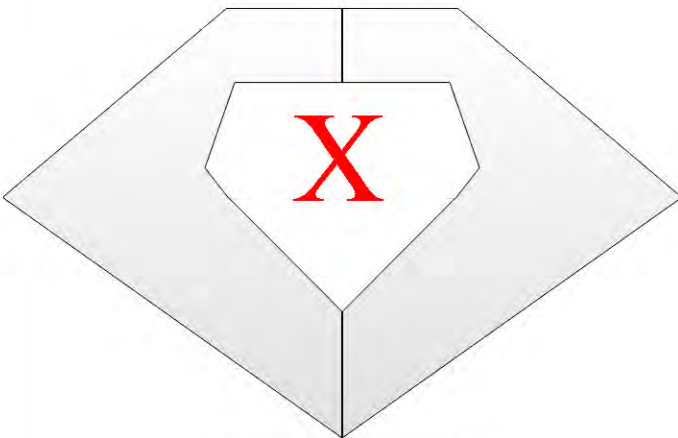
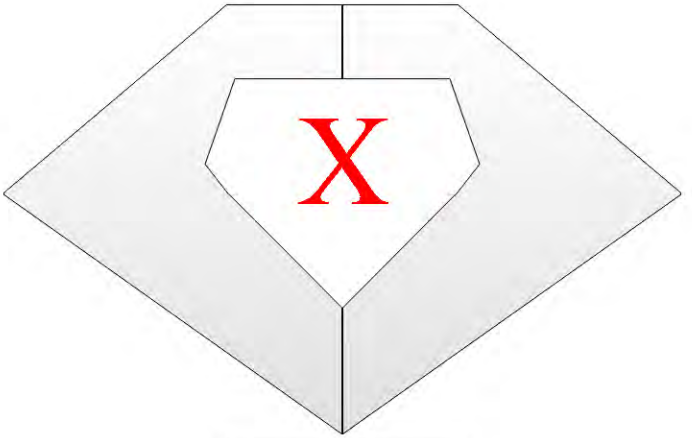
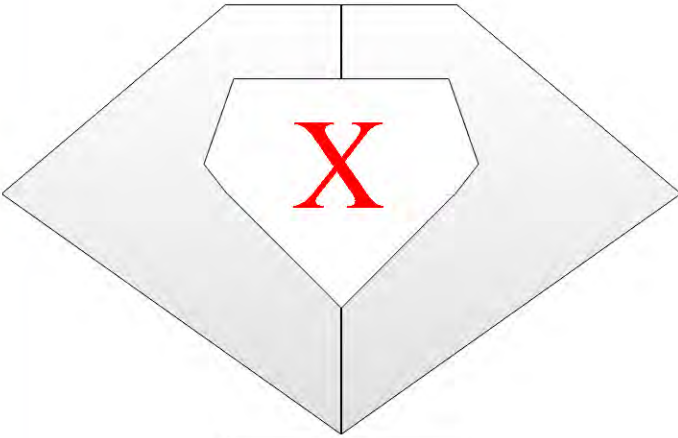
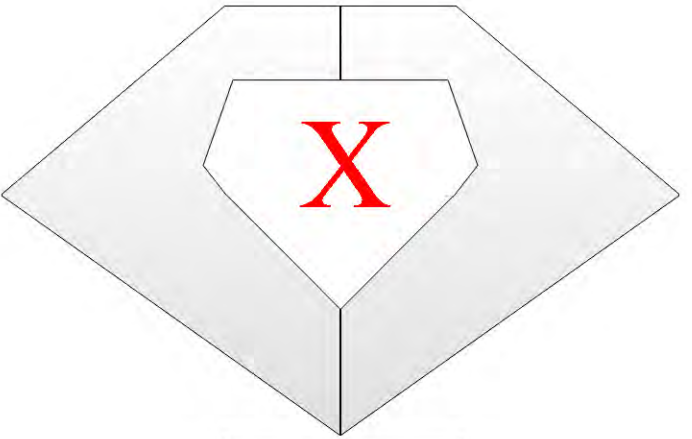
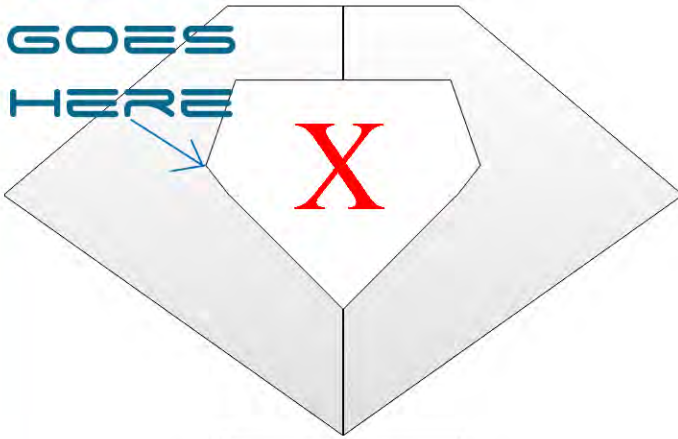
**SPACE MOUNTAIN BASE**
